- Build version: 4.1.0-15925
- I/O Filter version: 4.0.5.2426 and 4.1.0.2483

About vSphere 6.0

This release of Accelerator supports vSphere 6.5, 6.7, and 7.0 releases. ESXi 6.0 hosts are no longer supported.

Changes in this Release

Version 4.1.0 (2021-06-02)

This release comes with two I/O filters: an I/O filter version 4.0.5 for vSphere 6.5 and 6.7, and an I/O filter version 4.1.0 for vSphere 7.

Major features in this release:

- This is the first Infinio Accelerator release that supports vSphere 7.0. Since vSphere 6 I/O filters can no longer be installed on vSphere 7.0, this release comes with two builds of I/O filters, one for vSphere 6 and one for vSphere 7. The functionalities of the two I/O filter builds are identical.
- Infinio Management Console will now check the release versions of ESXi hosts and determine which I/O filter should be installed in a cluster.
- I/O filters can be installed on both vLCM clusters and VUM clusters; however, for vLCM clusters, users must manually remediate their hosts after the installation through vCenter UI. Similarly, users must also manually remediate the hosts after I/O filters are installed. An automatic solution is being investigated and will be included in a future Infinio Accelerator release.
